

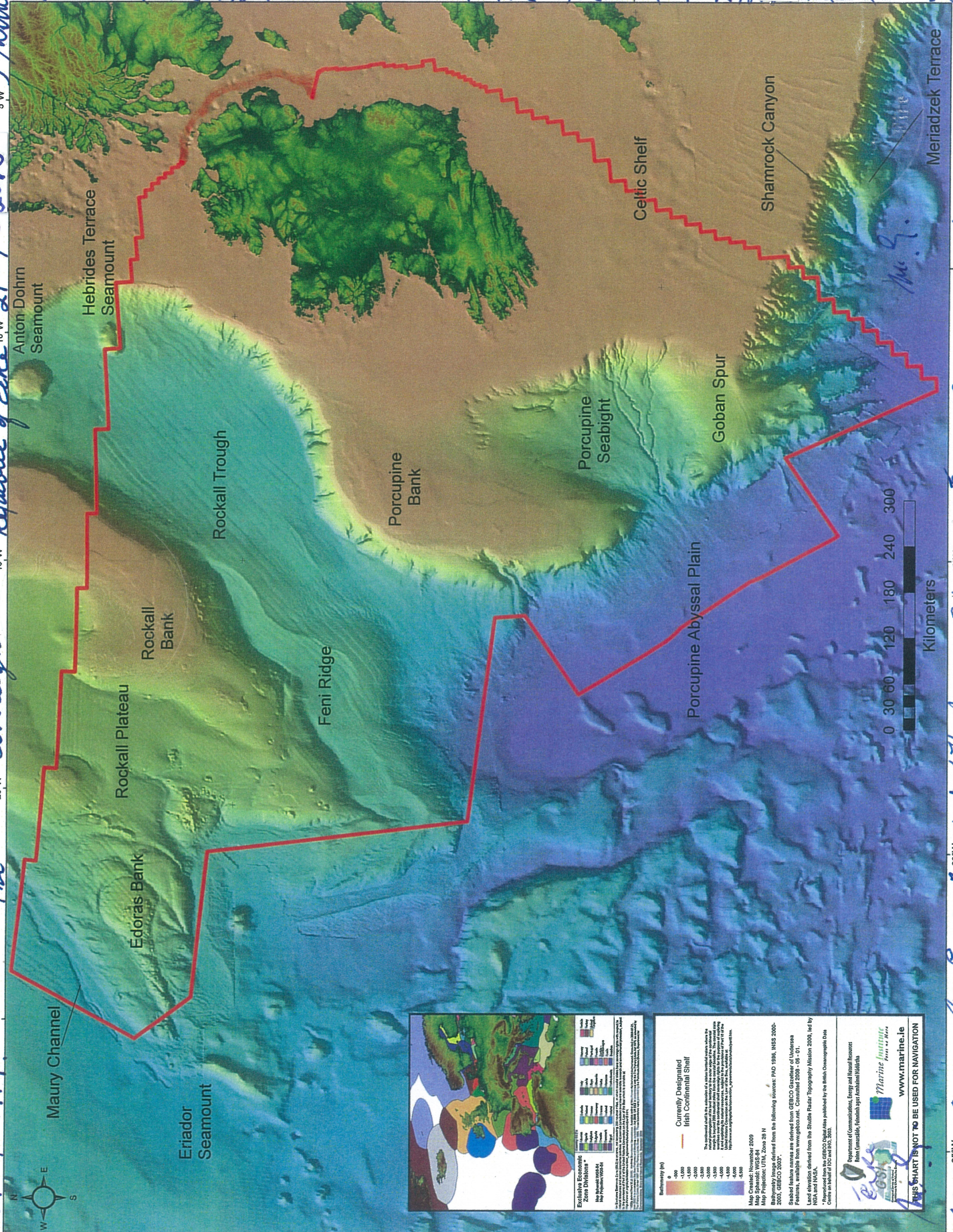

 The map shows the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of the Republic of Ireland, which extends 200 nautical miles from the coast. The EEZ is divided into several zones, including the Continental Shelf, the Exclusive Economic Zone, and the High Seas.

Currently Designated Irish Continental Shelf
 The map shows the currently designated Irish Continental Shelf, which extends to the edge of the continental shelf. The shelf is divided into several zones, including the Continental Shelf, the Exclusive Economic Zone, and the High Seas.
