be put back in the Cabinet Room
as it was for the First Dáil Eireann
I suggest over the fireplace and in
plaster or some other suitable substance.
The Trinity could be sculptured similar
to the Sovereign Seal that is in the Aras
an Machtdáin.

The Trinity is still over
The Four Courts, but is not properly
aligned to the Sovereign Republic of Eire
