Both Houses of the Oireachtas  
are not properly Constituted.

Please Remove the Sovereign  
Seal of Dáil Éireann (A.D) from the backs  
of the Chairs in Seanad Éireann and place  
the Harp (B.C.) With 12 Strings in an  
elevated position over the seat of the  
Cathaoirleach of Seanad Éireann and  
Return the Sovereign Seal of Dáil Éireann  
12 strings Anno Domini, a Christian  
symbol and Ethos back to Dáil Éireann  
and place the Sovereign Seal of Dáil  
Éireann, (AD 12 strings) in an elevated  
position over the seat of the Ceann Comhairle  
with the Tricolour. Then Both Houses of the  
Oireachtas are properly Constituted and not as  
is at present.
