GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Alien: A male or female irrespective of age not born in Ireland and who is resident

in Ireland and who does not have at least one parent that was born in Ireland.

Citizen: A male or female irrespective of age born and resident in Ireland or who is

resident in Ireland and has at least one parent born in Ireland.

Dáil Éireann: The Dáil established by the Will of the People of Ireland on 21st January

1919 and whose powers of governance of the Irish Republic were transferred from the IRB on condition that the Dáil follow the programme of the Brotherhood to the full letter of the law with the licence for their

operation being renewed each year on January 21st by the IRB.

Dáil Éireann Courts: The Courts established by the Will of the People of Ireland on 21st January

1919 to protect the rights of the Sovereign Man and Woman with the licence for their operation being renewed each year on January 21st by the IRB.

Exile: A male or female irrespective of age separated from his or her Country or

home voluntarily or by force of circumstances.

Independence Day: January 21st.

Ireland: The island of Ireland comprising Antrim, Armagh, Carlow, Cavan, Clare, Cork,

Derry, Donegal, Down, Dublin, Fermanagh, Galway, Kerry, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Leitrim, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Offaly, Roscommon, Sligo, Tipperary, Tyrone, Waterford, Westmeath, Wexford, &

Wicklow.

Irish Free State: The Crown Corporation to govern Carlow, Cavan, Clare, Cork, Donegal, Dublin,

Galway, Kerry, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Leitrim, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Offaly, Roscommon, Sligo, Tipperary, Waterford,

Westmeath, Wexford & Wicklow.

Irish Republic: The Sovereign Independent State inclusive of all of its territory land air and

water (including seas) and its natural resources (also: éire, Éire, Republic of

Ireland, Éireann, Éirinn).

National Economic Council:

The Advisory Body for the Government of the Irish Republic with Delegates representative of the various industrial and economic interests in the Republic including but not limited to **Agriculture**, **Fisheries**, **Minerals**, **Manufacturing**, **Distributing** (of home produce) **Transport** (including Highways, Railways, Canals, Shipping, Aviation) **Banking** and **The Gaedhealtacht**.

Sovereign Constitution:

The Constitution of the Republic of Ireland, proclaimed in arms on Easter Monday, April 24th, 1916, and established by the Will of the People of Ireland, on January 21st, 1919.

Sovereign Licence:

A Valid and Bona Fide Licence granted by the IRB subject to terms of usage for a calendar year up to January 20th and which may be reissued on January 21st subject to ongoing terms of usage.

The People of Ireland: Irishmen and Irishwomen.
