
Dear Dr Duisenberg,

I wish to complain and protest to the removal of the sovereign seal of Dáil Éireann from our legal Irish tender. Punt (Bank Notes) by the Central Bank of Ireland and the Department of Finance. It is Treason.

The Central Bank of Ireland and the Department of Finance has no right to interfere with the sovereign seals of Dáil Éireann or trespass into the sovereignty of Dáil Éireann.

The Harp is not a Legal
Tender.

The Sovereign seal of Dáil
Éireann only is the Legal Tender

The Harp is a Musical
instrument, for example the "Bláin Bonn"
Harp has 29 strings. The Harp is the
reverse side of the Sovereign seal of
Dáil Éireann and is also used by
Guinness as their Trade Mark.

The Sovereign seal of Dáil
Éireann has twelve ⑫ strings and
is a Christian symbol and Ethos

The Sovereign seal and the
Harp have been the symbol of the Irish
People for thousands of years. Especially

the "Ó" and the "^{II} Mac"

The Sovereign Seal on our Passport, (European Community). has nine ⑨ strings. We enter a Foreign Country as Sovereign Citizens

The Sovereign Seal on the Euro Coin has Fourteen ⑭ strings ?

The Sovereignty comes from the 1916 Proclamation and was implemented by my Granduncle Tom McGuire on the 21st of January 1919 in "Vaughans Hotel" 29 Parnell Square Dublin and the Sovereignty was Vested on the same day the 21st of January 1919 and my Granduncle Placed the Sovereign seal of Dóil Eikesnn in the Mansion House Dublin for the first Dóil Eikesnn on behalf of the Irish Republican Brotherhood

I am the Heir to "Vaughans Hotel" and the Present Sovereign Seal Holder. my family the McGuires have held the Sovereign Seals of Dóil Eikesnn for ⑬ Eightythree years on behalf of the Irish Republican Brotherhood

IV

The Sovereign Seals of Dail Éireann
are based on the design of the old
Irish Harp, The Brian Boru Harp
and the sequence of events. The Fenian
Brotherhood standard. The Sovereign
Seal on a green background with a
gold Braid, "The Green and Gold".
The Irish Republican Brotherhood
who are the successors of the Fenian
Brotherhood, Their standard is the
Sovereign seal on St Patrick's Blue
background with a Gold Braid
and after the 21st of January 1919. The
Irish Republican Standard. The
Sovereign Seal of Dail Éireann on
St Patrick's Blue background with
the Four Province Emblem of Ireland
and a Thirty two Gold Braiding Edge.

The Sovereign Seal of Dail Éireann
is over the Irish Courts and the Gaelic
Athletic Association (G.A.A.) is entitled to
have the Sovereign Seal of Dail Éireann on their
Emblem.

Tom McGuire did not place
a Harp in the Mansion^{House}, Dublin for the
First Dáil Éireann. Tom McGuire placed
the Sovereign seal of Dáil Éireann
which has 12 Twelve strings, in
the Mansion House for the First Dáil Éireann.

The Thirtytwo (32) counties election
of 1918. established the Sovereignty
of Dáil Éireann and the Sovereignty
of the Thirty two (32) Counties.

I would like to know how the
European Central Bank is going to
compensate the Irish Republican
Brotherhood for the Removal of their
Sovereign seal of Dáil Éireann
from the Irish Legal Tender. The Irish
Bank note. The Punt. ???

Does the European Central Bank
still acknowledge the Sovereignty of
Dáil Éireann as in the 1916 Proclamation
and Implemented and Vested in
"Vaughan Hotel", 29 Parnell Square Dublin
on the 21st of January 1919. and the Sovereignty
of the Thirty two (32) Counties and the Sovereignty

of the Sovereign Irish People
