On Easter Monday 1916.

The Irish and Fenian Republican Brotherhood (IRB). had only a Provisional Government. The IRB. had to wait for Great Britain to call the 32 county all Ireland Election on the 14<sup>th</sup> of December 1918.

On the 28<sup>th</sup> of December 1918, the Irish Republican Brotherhood (IRB, Sinn Féin). WON. 73 SEATS. The Unionist Party won. 25. SEATS, The Nationalist Party won 6. Seats, The Independent Party won 1. Seat  
TOTAL 105 SEATS
