Address by Secretary for Agriculture

It is now evident that the Common Agricultural Policies agreed by the Irish Free State Corporation Government has failed to protect biodiversity and create a sustainable standard for agriculture. This failure is due to the fact that Proper Procedure was not followed, and the entire process was a direct breach of several International Laws including the Aarhus Convention.

The Ministry of the IRB are now in the process of advancing a Common Agricultural Policy for the Sovereign Nation of Éire. Proposals on Environment matters have been agreed by consensus in public [S25C-7i22071810370 \(billymcguire.com\)](https://www.billymcguire.com) and we are now moving forward with the Social consultations.

Because of time constraints we will advance this electronically and the public meeting to agree the proposals is arranged for the 22-10-22 in the Thomas McDonagh Centre in Cloughjordan. I will be setting up a Facebook page where I expect to get a lot of Social concerns and proposals agreed by consensus to save time at the public meeting. This will also enable stakeholders that cannot attend Cloughjordan on the day to participate.

All mediators 'appointed' to the Irish Free State Corporation Governments CAP Consultative Committee are invited to attend this meeting. Our objective is to have a Bearable Sustainable Standard agreed by the 1-11-22 and we will then move on to the Economic Proposals for the Common Agricultural Policy for the January deadline.
