Glossary of Terms (6th Edition)

- Alien:** A Male or Female irrespective of age not born in Ireland and who is resident in Ireland and who does not have at least one parent that was born in Ireland.
- Alien Government:** A Government Organisation or Corporation that is not engaged or retained to protect the sovereign and indefeasible rights of Irishmen and Irishwomen.
- Citizen:** A Man or Woman's Entity.
- Citizen of Ireland:** A Sovereign Man or Woman in Éire utilising their Entity.
- Citizen of Ireland Inc.:** A Person born or naturalised in the State subject to the Jurisdiction thereof. One who is below in position, inferior and subject to the control, authority, power and legal right of a State, subject to the administrative rules, regulations and ordinances of the State where rights are given by qualifications.
- Citizen of Irish Republic:** One who, under the Constitution is a Member of a Community, owing allegiance to, and being entitled to, religious and civil liberty, equal rights and equal opportunities, with guarantee by Government.
- Certificate of Citizenship for the Irish Republic:**
Certificates of Citizenship of the Irish Republic for Sovereign Claimants in Éire in allegiance with the Irish Republic via Óglaigh na hÉireann
- Declaration of Independence:**
The Declaration of Independence of January 21st 1919.
- Declaration of Trust:** The expansion of the 1916 Proclamation by way of Declaration of Trust 8th April 2022 with Affirmation & Expansion 11th September 2023 and continuing.
- Deed of Acknowledgment and Confirmation:**
The Deed of the Sovereign Claimant in Éire sealed by the Executive of the IRB Supreme Council.

E.I.R.E.ie	The Domain Name for the Enrolment of Irelands Real Estate and the Protection of Private Property.
Executive:	The Executive of the Supreme Council of the Irish Republican Brotherhood consisting of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary.
Exile:	A male or female irrespective of age separated from his or her Country or home voluntarily or by force of circumstances.
Flag Charter:	The IRB Charter for the Flags of the Sovereign Republic of Éire.
Independence Day:	January 21 st .
I.R.B Executive Order 22-8-22:	Executive Order executed on 22 nd June 2022 for the reversion of authority transferred to Dáil Éireann on 21 st January 1919.
I.R.B Executive Order 4291:	Executive Order executed on 28 th July 2023 in furtherance of the duties of Dáil Éireann as provided for under I.R.B Executive Order 22-8-22.
Ireland:	The island of Ireland comprising Antrim, Armagh, Carlow, Cavan, Clare, Cork, Derry, Donegal, Down, Dublin, Fermanagh, Galway, Kerry, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Leitrim, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Offaly, Roscommon, Sligo, Tipperary, Tyrone, Waterford, Westmeath, Wexford, & Wicklow.
Irish Free State:	Carlow, Cavan, Clare, Cork, Donegal, Dublin, Galway, Kerry, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Leitrim, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Offaly, Roscommon, Sligo, Tipperary, Waterford, Westmeath, Wexford & Wicklow as governed to date by Crown Corporations.
Irish Republic:	The Sovereign Independent State inclusive of all land air and water and its natural assets and resources therein and thereof (also: ÉIRE , éire , Éire , Éire , Republic of Ireland , Éireann , Éirinn).
Irish Republican Brotherhood (IRB):	The Constitutional Organisation founded by James Stephens on March 17 th 1858 that operates under its Foregoing Constitution.
Óglaigh na hÉireann:	The Organisation A.K.A The Irish Volunteers, founded as Defenders and Protectors for the Sovereign Nation and Territory, by the IRB in 1913, with First Constitution on 25 th October 1914, in response to the establishment of the Ulster Volunteers, with the First Constitution updated by IRB on 17 th June 2023.
Seal Charter:	The IRB Charter for the Seals of the Sovereign Republic of Éire.
Sovereign Citizen:	A dweller or inhabitant in a city, town or place, with the state of exemption from the control of another. One who enjoys liberty and is not subject to the will of another.

Sovereign Constitution:

The Constitution of the Republic of Ireland, proclaimed in arms on Easter Monday, April 24th, 1916, and established by the Will of the People of Ireland, on January 21st, 1919, advanced by Maire Nic Suibhne in January 1930 and printed in the United States of America for the Government of the Republic of Ireland and formally adopted by the IRB Copy-Right Copy-Claim with International Seal of Recognition on 11th November 2023.

Sovereign Licence:

A Valid and Bona Fide Licence granted by the IRB subject to terms of usage for a calendar year up to January 20th and which may be reissued on January 21st subject to ongoing terms of usage.

Sovereign Seal:

Seals of the Sovereign Republic held In Trust for the People by IRB/ÓnahÉ.

Supreme Council:

The Governing Body of the Irish Republican Brotherhood.

The Common Good:

Sovereign and Indefeasible Rights of Men and Women protected communally.

The Dáil Éireann:

The Dáil established by the Will of the People of Ireland on 21st January 1919 and whose powers of governance of the Irish Republic were transferred from the IRB on condition that the Dáil follow the programme of the Brotherhood to the full letter of the law with the licence for their operation being renewed each year on January 21st by the IRB.

The Dáil Éireann Courts:

The Courts established by the Will of the People of Ireland on 21st January 1919 to protect the rights of the Sovereign Man and Woman with the licence for their operation being renewed each year on January 21st by the IRB.

The National Economic Council:

The Advisory Body for the Government of the Irish Republic with Delegates representative of the various industrial and economic interests in the Republic including but not limited to **Agriculture, Fisheries, Minerals, Manufacturing, Distributing** (of home produce) **Transport** (including Highways, Railways, Canals, Shipping, Aviation) **Banking** and **The Gaedhealtacht**.

The People of Ireland:

The Sovereign Irishmen and Irishwomen.

The Programme of the Brotherhood:

The prerequisite principles for governance of the Sovereign Republic of Éire.

The President:

The President of the Irish Republican Brotherhood.

The Tricolour:

The True Tricolour Flag of Green/White/Orange of the Sovereign Independent Nation State measuring 63" x 29.25" and held in Trust for the Sovereign Independent Nation State by the Irish Republican Brotherhood.

Title 4 Flag:

The Tricolour Flag of Green/White/Orange of the Sovereign Independent Nation State measuring 1.9" x 1" on document, and all other flags salvaged under the Hibernia Flag UPU Claim, held in Trust for the Sovereign Independent Nation State by the Irish Republican Brotherhood.
