The statement *"The main functions of the PRA are to manage and control the Land Registry and the Registry of Deeds and to promote and extend the registration of ownership of land. The PRA also operates the Ground Rents Purchase Scheme under the Landlord and Tenants Acts"* is noted on the Property Registration Authority (PRA) Website [prai.ie](http://prai.ie)

The Mission Statement of the Irish Republican Brotherhood (IRB) *"To Correct and Set and Protect the Position of the Sovereign Territory of Éire for the People of Ireland"* is noted on [IRBSupremeCouncil.ie](http://IRBSupremeCouncil.ie)

It has come to the attention of the IRB that implied functions of the PRA may be deficient regarding the protection of the position of the Sovereign Territory of Éire, and all the assets therein and thereof, for the People of Ireland, given the indistinctness of account of the mines and minerals, and also how the documents of the PRA serve to identify LEGAL INTEREST only. The PRA documents are apparently absent any recognition of the Equitable, Beneficial and/or Lodial Interest in the Properties as established in Law.

The IRB have maintained the Claim over the Sovereign Territory of Éire, and all the Assets Therein and Thereof, for the People of Ireland, each and every year since our 1916 Proclamation. Given the responsibility and authority in this regard, and in order to provide greater accessibility and awareness for the People of Ireland, the IRB have developed a Public Platform [e-i-r-e.ie](http://e-i-r-e.ie) for the People of Ireland to record Equitable, Beneficial and Lodial Interest in their property.
