Proclamation read by Colm G., John D. and John B.

1. I.R.B. policy on Arts, Culture and Heritage.

The proposed I.R.B. Policy on Arts, Culture and Heritage is read aloud by the Secretary for Arts, Culture and Heritage, Eileen M. T. Proposal was carried unanimously and without change. Signed off. Seal to be applied in GHO, Mermaid House on 27-8-2023.

2. Overseas Members.

A proposal was brought to the table that a provision be made to overseas members of the Supreme Council who are not able to attend meetings readily e.g. Jake Cingel. It was proposed that they be able to join remotely. The motion was carried unanimously without change with an effective date of 26-8-2023.

3. Mansion House

The Indenture for the Mansion House, Dublin, Éire was co-signed by Eileen-Mary T.

4. On ice.

A list of 60 names of those who oppose or hinder the I.R.B. was made. The names were "baptised" in water from the Jordan River and topped up with Proclamation water. The names will be kept "on ice" in GHQ.

5. Invitation to the House of David.

Members of the Supreme Council have been invited by the President, William-James McGuire

to join the House of David by sitting on the stone of David located in the stone circle at Lough Gur. William-James is the last known invitee into the House of David in the Womb of Sovereignty and only he has the authority to extend that invitation. This presented a conundrum to the Supreme Council as it was felt that the Vice-President, Josephine-Dolores had been compromised but it is not within our remit or capacity to admit or deny anyone who wished to accept the invitation.

The Chair, John-Declan F. makes the point that this is not just a ceremony and that accepting the invitation will mean greater responsibility. Concern was also raised that some of those named on the list of Point 4. would also be in attendance and may detract or diminish the importance of the event.

6. AOB.

Liaison Officer, John-Brian C. asks about the solar disk for the ceremony. The matter has been dealt with.
